Thank you for your letter of January 20, 2010 regarding Susan Lien's contention that Mr. Lorenz conveniently omitted providing our office with the findings of the Nebraska court.


Contrary to what you state in your letter, Mr. Lorenz did disclose all the information to our office regarding the trial proceedings in the Nebraska courts, including that which you sent to Minister Cannon and to our office, on January 20, 2010.

Perhaps Ms. Lien did not disclose to you the proceedings of the Supreme Court of British Columbia. On March 16, 2009, regarding the allegation that Mr. Lorenz physically and sexually abused his daughter, this Court found: "The mother's avoidance of the opportunity to have this matter properly resolved, based on a full hearing, is plainly not due to a want of energy or resources. She has by her attorney, participated in hearings before the Judicial Committee of the Nebraska Legislature. This, apparently, with such vigour that the Nebraska Legislature has seen fit to amend its child custody legislation."

In the event that Ms. Lien conveniently omitted providing you with that information, I have enclosed a copy for your elucidation.

I trust you will find the enclosure to be informative regarding Ms. Lien's character.
